- Throughout the day, experts in nearly every wildlife category will lead groups of participants with all levels of experience on walks of approximately two hours in length to record everything from birds and butterflies to wildflowers and trees.
- Participants may change groups as often as they wish in order to cover the wildlife groups that interest them.

**Do you have a special interest?** Specialists in all fields are needed to co-lead groups or act as informal teachers throughout the day, so if you have expertise in one or more plant or animal group, you can help. Volunteers also are needed to direct participants to the right groups and help with other management activities.
